PART ONE P/K/A ENRIQUE TORRES

Born 1959 in New York City (of Puerto Rican heritage). Lives and works in New York City.

Enrique Torres got into the emerging aerosol art scene in the early seventies, a scene in which he became one of the leading figures during the late seventies – then as a part of the prestigious group TDS (The Death Squad). He has worked under a range of different alias, but is most known as Part One. In the early eighties he was a part of the downtown art and club scene and showed at various venues such as Galozzi Laplaca Gallery, The Limelight, The Tunnel, Bakton and Downtime.

Today, Torres defines himself as an aerosol expressionist, and works in a wide range of mediums and formats. He's a sought after artist in various areas, exhibits his art in galleries and paints several dozens murals around NYC every year. His specialty is a wide and unique use of colors and formation of letter structures. The appreciation of his art has led him hired by artists such as KRS one, Big Pun, Kool G Rap and Terrorsquad, for whom he created murals. The German publisher *From Here to Fame* has recently released a book on Torres' work titled: Part One – The Death Squad.

Torres is also co-director of the prestigious Manhattan Graffiti Hall of Fame in Spanish Harlem, New York.
